## **Nova Central School Board Appoints New Director of Education**

Mr Charlie McCormack has been appointed Director of Education for Nova Central School District by the NCSD Board of Trustees. He will assume the Director's position on September 1, 2011, following the retirement of current Director, Ms. Cindy Fleet.

Mr. McCormack has been the Assistant Director of Education for Programs for the past ten years. ## **BACKGROUND**

Nova Central School District extends from the Baie Verte Peninsula to the Connaigre Peninsula, to Fogo Island, to the Eastport Peninsula, with a total geographic area of 45,500 kilometres. The district is governed by a volunteer Board of Trustees, elected or appointed to represent 15 zones throughout Central Newfoundland.

NCSD operates 66 schools in 50 communities, with school sizes ranging from two students to over 900. The district provides educational programming and services to over 12,000 students and has approximately 2500 full-time, part-time and casual employees.
