Nova Central School District to Hold Annual Conference

Nova Central School District will hold its annual professional development conference in October 2010 for all teaching and support staff. **All staff from the Gander-Lewisporte-Twillingate-New Wes Valley and Connaigre Peninsula areas will attend the conference on October 7-8 in Gander**, and all staff from Baie Verte-Springdale-Grand Falls-Windsor – Botwood areas will attend the conference on October 14-15 in Grand Falls-Windsor.

The theme of the conference is LEARN – DISCOVER – ACHIEVE. Professional development sessions will be offered for all staff relating to the delivery of curriculum in the classroom and the operation of schools. A total of almost 300 sessions are planned for both conference locations, on a wide variety of topics.

Nova Central School District has approximately 2500 full-time and part-time staff members and we are one of the largest employers in Central Newfoundland. The district covers a large geographic area, ranging from Westport on the Baie Verte Peninsula to Charlottetown, from Harbour Breton to Fogo Island and all points in between.
